Where: On-site @ Byron Center and/or Grand Rapids West

Role: Caring for the youngest children (infants and toddlers), giving their moms an opportunity to participate in faith conversations, counseling, or life skills classes during Monday Meets.

When: Mondays from 4:30pm-6:00pm and/or 6:00pm-7:30pm (September - June) **Volunteer for dates that are convenient for you!**

Training: Complete Volunteer training prior to volunteering

Scheduled with the Volunteer Coordinator at your preferred location

<u>Mentor</u>

Where: Off-site paired with moms from either Byron Center or Grand Rapids West

Role: Spend one-on-one time with a single mom listening, sharing, and supporting her as she works towards her goals.

- Connect with your mentee mom each week
 by phone or text.
- Meet with your mentee mom in person 1-2 times per month.
- Commit to a minimum of 6 months 1 year

When: Meet at a time that works with your schedule!

Training: Complete Volunteer & mentor training prior to volunteering

Scheduled with the Volunteer Coordinator at your preferred location



Y Meal Group Volunteer

Where: On-site @ Byron Center and/or Grand Rapids West

Role: Be a part of providing hospitality and nourishment on Monday evenings. This role includes preparing and/or serving dinner to the single moms and children at Monday Meets. **Works best with a team of 2-4 people**

How:

- Prepare a meal off-site or order a meal for a group of 50-60 (single moms & children)
- Serve and clean up after the meal (optional)

When: Mondays from 5:00pm-6:45pm (September - June)

Volunteer for dates that are convenient for you!

Training: Complete Volunteer training prior to volunteering if serving the meal (lead/head volunteer only)

Scheduled with the Volunteer Coordinator at your preferred location

Prayer Group Volunteer

Where: On-site @ Byron Center or Grand Rapids West

When: Monthly on your own. Scheduled in-person prayer times will be Tuesday mornings @ 10am

Role: Supporting Hope Unexpected through prayer on a monthly basis. We will gather in person four times a year to pray together. Team members will be given a monthly schedule of specific topics to lift up in prayer as well as a prayer journal.

Development Office Volunteer


Where: On-site @ Byron Center
